

Thunderbird: How to update hostname in Thunderbird.

Thunderbird is a free, open-source email client that allows you to manage your emails from various email providers.

If you are using Thunderbird and need to update your hostname with mail.elite.uk as the incoming server and smtp.relay.elite.net.uk as the outgoing server, follow these simple steps:

1. Launch Thunderbird on your system.
2. Click on the menu icon (three horizontal lines) at the top right corner of the screen.
3. Select "Options" from the drop-down menu.
4. In the left-hand panel, click on "Account Settings."
5. Select the account you want to update from the list of accounts.
6. In the "Server Settings" section, you will see the "Server Name" field. Enter "mail.elite.uk" as the incoming server.
7. In the "Outgoing Server (SMTP)" section, click on the "Edit" button.
8. In the "Server Name" field, enter "smtp.relay.elite.net.uk" as the outgoing server.
9. Click "OK" to save the changes.
10. Close the "Account Settings" window.

Congratulations! You have successfully updated your hostname on Thunderbird with mail.elite.uk as the incoming server and smtp.relay.elite.net.uk as the outgoing server.
